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LINAK® information about the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA)

To LINAK customers,

The 'Toxic Substances Control Act' (TSCA) empowers the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to restrict the use of certain substances, such as persistent, bioaccumulative, and toxic (PBT) chemicals, to help reduce exposure.

On 6 January 2021, the EPA issued final rules under Section 6(h) of the TSCA. These rules became effective on 5 February 2021, restricting the use of five PBT chemicals:

- 2,4,6-tris (tert-butyl) phenol ("2,4,6-TTBP")
- Decabromodiphenyl ether ("DecaBDE")
- Hexachlorobutadiene ("HCBD")
- Pentachlorothiophenol ("PCTP")
- Phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1) ("PIP (3:1)")

To the best of our knowledge, none of these five chemicals are present in LINAK products.

LINAK will continue to monitor the presence of these chemicals in LINAK products.
